# A word from Pastor John ...

## - Christmas -

In Isaiah 61:1 it says, "He has sent me to bind up the broken hearted." Christmas is a time we celebrate the coming of Christ. It is a time when Christ wants to be born in our hearts anew. If we are the hands and feet of Christ, how do we bind up the broken hearted? We may think of, "to bind" as to tie up or immobilize. That is not what is meant here. It is a picture of putting a bandage on a wound, to care for someone who has been

injured. We are injured many different ways. We can slip on the ice and hurt our back but it is so much more than that. It may be the loss of a love one, or a job. It could have been sitting on the bench while the other kids got to play. Or may be you were raised in a home where love was based on performance. I knew a young man once who told me his father always said, "he wasn't good enough." I counseled a young woman who was taken at a young age by her dad's brother and never got to experience growing up normally. There are so many broken hearted out there this Christmas season. December is a big month for suicide in the United States. The contrast of the Christmas season and their broken hearts are just too much. When Mary Magdalene was at the tomb

Easter morning she was crying and staring into an empty tomb. She was crying for the man who had meant so much to her. Jesus who had delivered her of demonic possession. She had placed so much hope in Jesus, now He was gone. Her world was shattered. Then Jesus says to her, "Why are you crying?" Alive! Jesus told her to go to his disciples and tell them he was alive. Mary tells them, "I have seen the Lord!" What hope! Mary

wasn't thinking about going to heaven, that wasn't even a thought. To her the story continues. Jesus is alive, the ministry of "binding up the broken hearted" goes on. The disciples looked at the resurrection as, "Jesus beat this death thing so can we." What can stop us? They went out and changed the world. Can we with Mary say, "I have seen the Lord!" Is He real this Christmas season in your life? What are you doing to "bind up the broken hearted?" Jesus does live on and He wishes to do so in your life. He still asks the question, "why are you crying?" Let us be those eyes, ears and hands this Christmas season and "bind up the broken hearted."
