He desires to be in relationship with us and we with each other. Relationships take an investment of time and creativity. The kids may not be at home any longer but how about your relationship with your spouse? May be you are a widow, then whom are you mentoring or building a relationship with? If divorced then with whom are you, "making the most of your time" with? We must all resist the trap of crowded loneliness. Many sociologists see loneliness as the number one problem in a world of 7 billion people. People are reached for the kingdom of God through relationships. Its not a fancy preacher or having the best Sunday School. It is accomplished one on one, taking the time for others. Our mates, neighbor, new person at church, grand kids, or own children, who are those God is putting in your life? We need to commit to prayer that we will have the ability to focus on others and not allow activity to replace relationships. Let us, "make the most of our time."
