"Being a Grave Digger" June 2021

All Christians need to have a little bit of a "grave digger' in them. Let me explain what I mean. I had a neighbor once who said, "I'm going to take this out to the back forty and bury it." He was talking about some past mistake, sin or issue in his life. When the disciple fell asleep in the garden with Jesus they realized what they had done and it produced despair. This kind of despair is common to every human. If I had only done this! If I had not done that! I would like to have that back again! The terrible tormentors of past mistakes keep

biting at the consciousness of our minds. Whenever we realize that we have blown it, we are apt to sink into despair. I want to share some words from Oswald Chambers in his book, *My Utmost for His Highest*, Jesus comes to us and says, "Sleep on it now, the opportunity is lost." Make sure that we sleep on it in the bosom of Christ. Let the past be in the past. If it is some sin confess it. If it is some decision we regret, give it to Him. Take it out back and bury it and don't dig it up. There are experiences like this in all our lives, and we are tempted to despair. The disciples did an unforgivable thing; they went to sleep instead of watching with Jesus. But what did Jesus do with it? He came with spiritual initiative and told them to get on with life.

Go do the next thing I tell you. Go dig a grave and bury it. If we are living for Christ, then lets get on with it. We must trust him that when he says he will forgive us, he will forgive us. Leave it with him and move on. Don't let the past determine your future. With Christ each day has new opportunities to serve. Never allow your sense of failure to corrupt any new action. Become a good grave digger. Take your issues to Christ, bury them in his bosom and leave them there.
